Back on Track: Zyre's Story





Zyre was in the foster care system from ages 9 to 16. For the past two years, he has been homeless and without consistent adult supervision. Zyre still managed to attend Reading High until this past February when he dropped out of his senior year. Zyre, now 18, came to The Mission on April 8th. Since arriving, case management and life coaching assisted Zyre in obtaining his birth certificate, social security card, state ID, food stamps, medical coverage, and a cell phone. Zyre was reinstated at Reading High on April 15th, and he is set to graduate on time! Zyre will also be attending his Senior Prom proudly wearing his school colors with help from his Case Manager. Thanks to your support, Zyre got his life and future back on track at a pivotal time to graduate! Zyre is currently taking steps to enlist in the Army and enroll in the Human Services program at RACC.



What led you to come to LightHouse?

My kids are 5 and 7 and I lost my childcare suddenly in the middle of the summer because I could not find a daycare that had availability and accepted my childcare subsidy. Without childcare, I lost my job and couldn't work.

What has your experience been at LightHouse?

It's been interesting. There's been a lot of help, but it's also been a learning experience living with other women with trauma. When you're in a situation like this, you're forced to learn to live with people you wouldn't typically have to. The help has been a blessing. And if I hadn't been here when I lost child support I would have been homeless because I relied on that income. I firmly believe that God has guided us here. It hasn't been all roses and butterflies but overall, it's been a blessing.

What would you like people to know about you or your situation?

Homelessness can happen to anyone. I was making really good money before I lost my job. I didn't stress about bills or anything. Being here has taught me to truly trust God. That lesson in itself has been wild. If I just ask Him it will happen. Put your faith in Him and watch the miracles happen.
